It's back! Another chance to see if you can race one of the historic Beamish trams around the circuit.

The 1.5 mile Fun Run matches man against machine and is open to all ages. Runners must try to beat the tram around one lap of the track that circles the Museum site.

For the more experienced competitors over the age of 16 the 10k (approx.) multi-terrain race gives the opportunity to race the tram around one circuit of the track then follow

scenic trails and paths through the Museum grounds.

There will be a trophy for the first to beat the tram in each race, prizes in all categories and a memento for all finishers.

Beamish Tram Challenge 2010 is being organised in partnership with Beamish Development Trust, Grace House North East Hospice Appeal and Derwentside Athletic Club.

Registration fees will be used by Beamish Development Trust to fund local schools and community groups, operating in areas of high deprivation, to visit Beamish Museum and have the opportunity to engage with their heritage.

All sponsorship money raised by competitors will go to Grace House North East Children's Hospice Appeal, which is raising money to build, equip and run the new eight bed hospice for local children and their families
